Nawalakw is looking for a Health and Wellness Manager to join our team. This management role will research, design, deliver and expand on holistic health and wellness programming for Kwakwaka'wakw people - responsible for all aspects of development and delivery of these programs at hi'manis ḵakuṯa'atsi. The successful candidate will work closely with Language, Camp, and Training team leaders to coordinate a consistent set of opportunities offered in this setting. In addition to planning for, coordinating and facilitating health and wellness programs, events, retreats, workshops and training opportunities, the work will also include:

- Building relationships with communities, knowledge keepers, health partners and schools to understand needs and develop culturally grounded wellness initiatives
- Coordinating partnership opportunities with key stakeholders, health organizations and service providers to expand programs, using our youth camps as a model, and conducting research on program effectiveness with support from Nawalakw partners
- Building and leading a team to deliver programming and overseeing program coordination, managing financial administration, and sourcing funding opportunities
